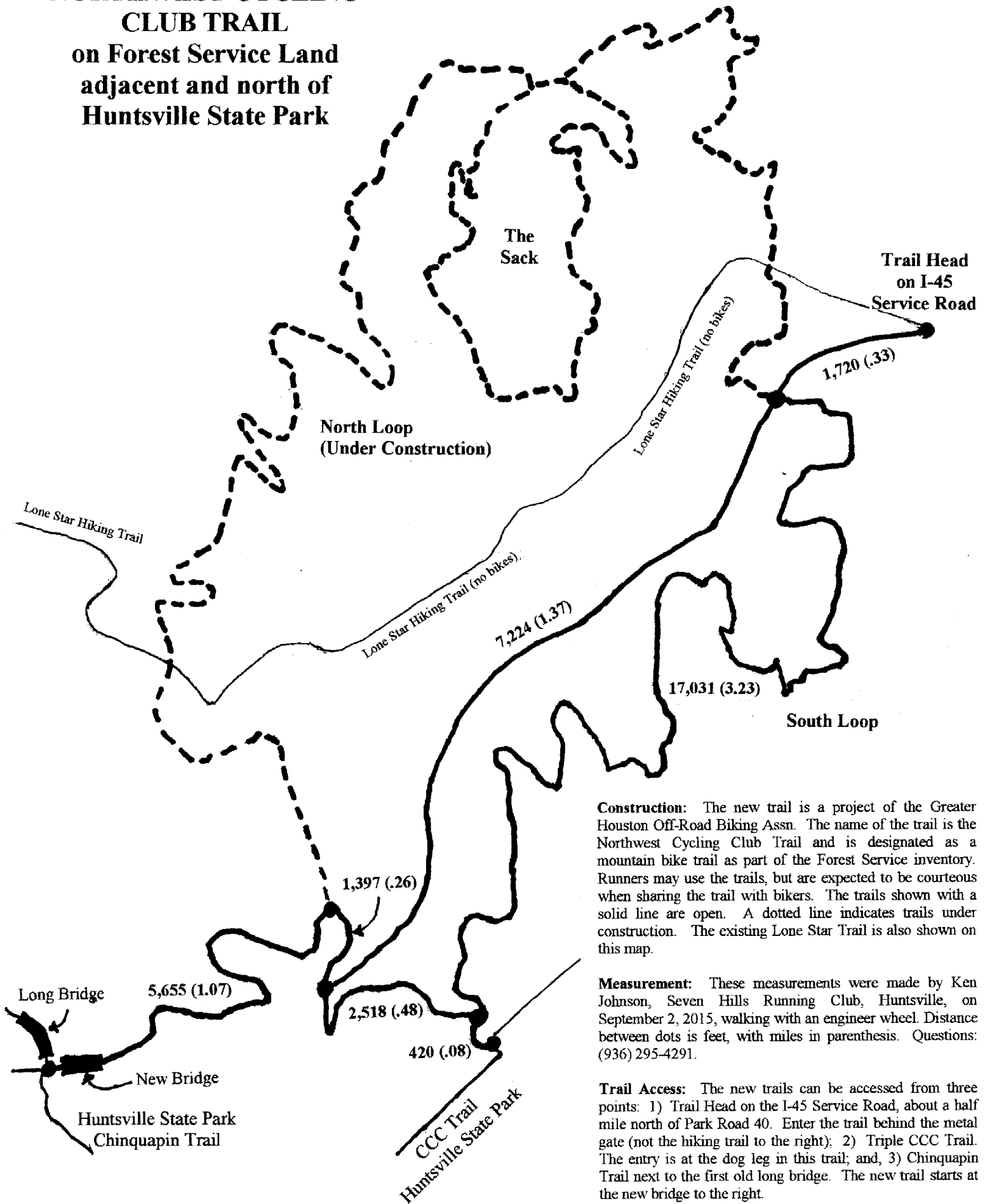


NORTHWEST CYCLING CLUB TRAIL
on Forest Service Land
adjacent and north of
Huntsville State Park



Construction: The new trail is a project of the Greater Houston Off-Road Biking Assn. The name of the trail is the Northwest Cycling Club Trail and is designated as a mountain bike trail as part of the Forest Service inventory. Runners may use the trails, but are expected to be courteous when sharing the trail with bikers. The trails shown with a solid line are open. A dotted line indicates trails under construction. The existing Lone Star Trail is also shown on this map.

Measurement: These measurements were made by Ken Johnson, Seven Hills Running Club, Huntsville, on September 2, 2015, walking with an engineer wheel. Distance between dots is feet, with miles in parenthesis. Questions: (936) 295-4291.

Trail Access: The new trails can be accessed from three points: 1) Trail Head on the I-45 Service Road, about a half mile north of Park Road 40. Enter the trail behind the metal gate (not the hiking trail to the right); 2) Triple CCC Trail. The entry is at the dog leg in this trail; and, 3) Chinquapin Trail next to the first old long bridge. The new trail starts at the new bridge to the right.
