Marathon, race attendance declining across region

If you race a lot, you can't help but notice: attendance is down. A race that had 500 runners last year might have only 400 this year.

Not every race has experienced a decline, but many have. In Bryan/College Station, the BCS Marathon is 20% off its peak. The Texas 10 Series has seen similar declines in several cities, including Huntsville. And October's Huntsville Half Marathon was down more than half, compared to five years ago.

Steve Allen, President of the Seven Hills Running Club, puts some of the blame on Hurricane Harvey. "The impact that it has had on so many people's lives reduced the number of runners this year."

But that can't be all of it. Veteran racer and race announcer Jon Walk told me, "Even those races that are produced better than most are down. There's a glut of races out there. The sport needs some contraction, especially in large metropolitan areas such as Houston, the Metroplex, and San Antonio."

That makes sense to me. It turns out that people pay more attention to their health when the economy is down. That increased the amount of running during the recession, and increased the number of races. Now that the economy is stronger, people run less, so you have more races chasing fewer runners. Things won't return to normal until some races shut down.

What to do in the meantime? Houston running guru Loren Sheffer may have the answer. "You can improve if you go to events every weekend, and talk to runners and pass out fliers. Numbers can improve, but you have to put in the time in to get there. A web site and a Facebook page, and doing nothing else, is not getting the job done anymore."
