Grant, Villines win Dog Days 5K

Sheridan Grant and Emily Villines were the overall winners at the Dog Days 5K Run in Huntsville on Saturday. The 3.1-mile race was held in the Forest Hills Subdivision and was sponsored by the Seven Hills Running Club.

Grant completed the distance in 17 minutes, 20 seconds. Villines finished in 25 minutes, 15 seconds.

Grant, who is 19 years old runs on the cross-country and track teams at Pomona College in Los Angeles and is a 2011 graduate of Huntsville High School. Villines, who is 15 years old, is a sophomore at Huntsville High School and a member of the track and cross country teams.

Villines' sister, Mandie, was first in the 1-mile race with a time of 7 minutes, 51 seconds. Not far behind was Hutton Edney, 7 years old, with a time of 8 minutes, 18 seconds.
