RUNNING SHORTS O'Brien-Nolen, Arellano win Huntsville Half Marathon By Ken Johnson

Alfredo Arellano, 22, of San Antonio and Jacqueline O'Brien-Nolan, 48, of Kingwood were the overall winners in the 35th Annual Huntsville Half Marathon on October 19.

Arellano ran track at Colby Community College in Kansas and at Sam Houston State University. He is now the cross country coach at Alpha Omega Academy in Huntsville and an assistant to the track coach at Sam Houston State University. This was his first half marathon. He completed the hilly 13.1-mile distance in 1 hour, 18 minutes and 3 seconds.

O'Brien-Nolen is a very accomplished marathoner and ultra-marathoner and has become the most senior female runner to win the Huntsville Half Marathon. She finished in 1 hour, 36 minutes and 47 seconds, bettering her time last year by about three minutes.

In the quarter marathon race (6.55 miles), Trinity runner, Jose Torres, 20, was the overall male winner. He finished in 43 minutes and 13 seconds. Torres was last year's half marathon winner. Kas Kramer, 26, graduate of Sam Houston State University, now living in Conroe, was the fastest female. She finished in 53 minutes and 18 seconds.

The 5K (3.1 miles) race, Carlo Deason, 44, of Houston was the fastest male, with a time of 18 minutes and 7 seconds. This was the eighth time Deason has won the Huntsville 5K. Kelly Swanson, 32, of Houston won the female division with a time of 19 minutes and 34 seconds.
