Dan Byrne shines at Texas 10 Series in Huntsville

Huntsville's Dan Byrne was the fastest local runner at the Texas 10 Series road race in Huntsville on Sunday, Sept. 27. He finished the 10.4-mile course in a blistering 1 hour, 10 minutes and 17 seconds. This placed him 3rd in a field of 358 very competitive runners from all over Texas. He was 1st in the Males Masters Division (40 and older).

Byrne, 57, is a retired Texas Department of Criminal Justice Facilities Division manager and a member of the Seven Hills Running Club in Huntsville.

The Texas 10 Series is held in seven cities annually and consists of a 10-mile, 5-mile and 1-mile run. Due to an error in placing a turnaround point on the course, the 10-mile race was actually 10.4 miles and the 5-mile course was 5.2 miles. All three races started and finished on the Sam Houston State University campus.

There were a total of 550 runners completing the three races, making it the largest road race ever held in Huntsville. The next race in the series will be held in Fort Worth next Sunday.
