More than 450 runners in town for annual race

There were over 450 runners in Huntsville for the 34th Annual Huntsville Half Marathon & 5K Run/Walk held on October 27. This is up from just over 400 last year.

This is event of the Seven Hills Running and is the fourth oldest half marathon of nearly 100 in Texas. Runners had a choice between a half marathon (13.1 miles), a quarter marathon (6.55 miles) and a 5K (3.1 miles). Most ran the half marathon.

All three races started and finished at the Health & Kinesiology Center on the Sam Houston State University campus. The hilly course is challenging, especially for the Houston-area runners who are accustomed to flat courses.

Jose Torres, 19, of Trinity was the male winner in the half marathon with a time of 1:20:27. Sara Collazos, 23, of Houston and a recent graduate of Sam Houston State University, won the female division with a time of 1:36:22.

In the quarter marathon, Chad Martin, 23, of Coppell, Texas was the fastest male with a time of 36:22. Emily Denny, 23, of Trophy Club, Texas won the female division with a time of 44:42.

He is proud of the way volunteers from the community came together to welcome, serve and support the runners.
