Our August club run had a wonderful turnout, almost fifty people! So don't forget out next club run, coming up this Saturday:

Saturday, September 24, 8 am: Fall Fun Run, 10K, 5K and 1-Mile Run/Walk, Veterans Memorial Parkway, Huntsville. Meet at the south end of the West Hill Mall parking lot. \$1 entry. Register at the starting point.

Just like last year, we will be doing this run in conjunction with the Ruck March, which begins in the same parking lot. (They march on the street, and we run on the sidewalk opposite. Our path will not be obstructed.)

To make sure it is easy to find us, we will be setting up our canopy with our club banner slightly \*east\* of our usual spot. Instead of being on the corner of Veterans Pkwy. and Col. We will be taking an additional, voluntary collection during registration to help support the Ruck March.
