One thing for sure, Huntsville will be well-represented at the 25th Annual Polish Pickle 5K (3.1 miles) in Bremond on June 22.

The Polish Pickle 5K (and kid's 1K) is held each June as part of the Polish Day festivities in this small town of Bremond, north of Hearne.

Over 600 runners and walkers will participate in the 5K and then feast on Polish food and drink. Cash, medals and jars of pickles are given to the race winners. One lucky participant will win a heifer (or \$500 cash) or 30 bales of hay (or \$100 cash) in the door prize drawing.

The entry fee is only \$15 and that comes with a race T-shirt, all you can eat and drink and an entry for the door prize drawing.

After the race, shop the booths up and down Main Street and watch the pickle parade at 10 a.m.
